of February. Each Mode (NHTSA, FMCSA, FHWA and RITA) will host a webinar quarterly. The DOT TRCC Executive Committee is interested in hearing what topics you would like us to include. One suggested topic was "How States can enhance/improve/increase BAC testing and reporting of drivers involved in fatal crashes".

DOT TRCC Action: Hold a Webinar on the 408 applications - common mistakes – Jack Oates and the 408 Review Team held a webinar on February 25th the Webinar summary and Q&A's will be posted to the DOT TRCC website.

DOT TRCC Action: Coordinate and align State and DOT TRCC Projects. Hold Webinars, provide updates – Currently being examined and considered.

DOT TRCC Action: Provide an outside discussion area for stake holders to share information. Currently being examined and considered.

Request from Audience: States need Executive training available from DOT agencies. Beginning in the fall of 2010, the NHTSA Traffic Records Team will be sponsoring an Executive Orientation. The orientation will be coordinated through our NHTSA Regions. Also, Traffic Records 101 provides *Executives in Transition*, an Internet base data training on *Traffic Records 101* basics for Executives coming into office.

Request from Audience: Flag changes in training. *Traffic Records 101* can send you an email stating there had been updates to the curriculum however, the user must notify the Administrator that you would like to receive updated.

Request from Audience: TR assessments – can we work more holistic by adding an option for States to add on roadway and other issues. The traffic records assessment process is currently being examined and revised.

Request from Audience: Assist in building relationships with federal partners who have state agencies net on records (health, justice, medical examiners). The Traffic Records team is currently embarking on a new 5 year plan that will foster new relationships and provide a better foundation for partnering.
